



# Terms and Conditions for School of Management Taught Postgraduate Masters Scholarships 2018-2019

(For scholarships offered by the School of Management)

## **1 Scope**

These terms and conditions apply to new fee-paying full-time Taught Postgraduate Masters students taking up a place of study in 2018/19 entry, who are identified by the University as eligible for consideration for one of the Taught Postgraduate Masters Scholarships. They specifically apply to the School of Management MSc Scholarships.

Please note that there are other scholarships schemes for fee-paying Taught Postgraduate Masters students which have separate guidelines. Please see University of Bath website for full details.

The allocation of the scholarship is competitive and so not all applications received may be successful. Please see below for details on how selection is made. Only successful recipients of an award will be notified.

There are several scholarships as outlined below. All the scholarships are awarded in the form of a fee waiver ('discount') which is a sum of money to assist fee-paying students with tuition fees. The University allocates a waiver to your fee account in place of some of the fee liability you would otherwise have. There is no cash alternative to a fee waiver. Scholarships cannot be deferred and are for the 2018-2019 academic entry year only.

Eligible candidates will be invited to apply for a scholarship by the School of Management via an email link to a scholarship form.

This document outlines the full terms and conditions of this scheme and you should read these before you submit your application.

## **2. Eligibility**

If you wish to be considered for one the School of Management Taught Postgraduate Masters Scholarships you MUST:

- have received an offer to study one of our Taught Postgraduate Master's courses in the School of Management for the entry year 2018/19; and
- Paid your deposit within the four week deadline as stated on your offer letter; and
- Applied for a scholarship within the scholarship application deadlines;  
For students with Overseas fee status: this is by the 1 June 2018  
For students with Home/EU fee status: this is by the 1 August 2018;

If you have not done so, you cannot be considered for any of the scholarships outlined below.

Some scholarships also have additional specific eligibility criteria which must be met by all potential applicants. These additional criteria are based on the applicant's fee status, (whether it is International, Home (UK) or Home (EU),) or their nationality and on occasion where the applicants have studied previously. Please see the current specific scholarship details below for more details.

#### India Full tuition fee Scholarships (2 available Scholarships)

This scholarship will be to the value of the successful recipients' tuition fees in full for their MSc taught programme. To be considered for one of these scholarships you must be an Indian national and be based in India at the time of making your application.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

Applicants who are eligible for the Home (UK) or Home (EU) fee status are not eligible for these awards.

**Country / region Scholarships** (1 available scholarship for 1 national for each named Country/region which includes and is limited to, USA / Canada / Indonesia / Taiwan / Thailand / Middle East / China).

The Middle East for this purpose includes Syria, Israel, Iran, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Iraq, State of Palestine, Lebanon, Jordan, Qatar, Yemen, Oman, Bahrain, Kuwait, and Turkish Cyprus.

These Country / region specific scholarships are worth £10,000 each towards successful applicant's tuition fees and to be considered for one of them you need to be a national of the particular named country / region.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

Applicants who are eligible for the Home (UK) or Home (EU) fee status are not eligible for these awards.

### **Country / region Scholarships for Europe** (5 available scholarships)

There are five European Country / region scholarships worth £10,000 each towards successful applicant's tuition fees. To be considered for one of them you need to be a Student with Home (EU) fee paying status.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

Applicants who are eligible for the International fee status and Home (UK) are not eligible for these awards.

### **Country / region Scholarships for UK** (4 available scholarships)

There are four UK Country / region scholarships worth £10,000 each towards successful applicant's tuition fees. To be considered for one of them you need to be a Home (UK) fee paying Student.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

Applicants who are eligible for the International fee status and Home (EU) are not eligible for these awards.

### **Worldwide Scholarship** (20 available scholarships)

There are twenty Worldwide scholarships worth £5,000 each towards successful applicant's tuition fees. To be considered for one of these scholarships you must meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

### **Sir Jack Cater Scholarship** All subject areas | Hong Kong | Taught Postgraduate Masters (MSc)

The Sir Jack Cater Scholarship is worth £3,000 towards successful applicant's tuition fees and to be considered for this scholarship you must be an international fee-paying taught master's applicant who is a graduate of either Hong Kong University, or The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) or Hong Kong Baptist University. This scheme includes stand-alone Masters of Research (MRes) programmes and is open to all subjects of study including those in the School of Management.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

### **Santander Masters Scholarships for students in Latin America**

Latin America | Taught Postgraduate Masters (MSc)

There are five Santander Masters Scholarships each worth £5,000 towards successful applicant's tuition fees. To be considered for one of them Students must be a graduate of a university in the Santander network in one of the following countries: Argentina; Brazil; Chile; Colombia; Mexico; Peru, Puerto Rico; Uruguay and they must also be an international fee paying student.

To be considered for one of these scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

### **University of Bath India Scholarships 2018**

School of Management | India International | Taught Postgraduate Masters MSc)

There is one India Scholarship 2018 worth £5,000 towards successful applicant's tuition fees. To be considered for one of these scholarships you must be an Indian national and be based in India at the time of making your application as an international fee paying full-time taught masters applicant.

To be considered for this scholarships you must also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in section 2 above.

## **4. Application**

You must apply using the application form link provided in the personal email invitation by the School of Management. No applications will be accepted after the deadline dates or in any other format.

It is the University's responsibility to identify potential scholarship recipients on the basis of information provided in your scholarship and study application. The University cannot be responsible for any errors or omissions in the information supplied to it and on which eligibility decisions are based. The University's decision on the interpretation of eligibility criteria is final and there is no right of appeal. You must comply with all requests for additional information to establish your eligibility on the timeframes specified and you must submit any evidence requested by deadlines.

### **Changes to study**

If you change to a non-eligible programme or mode of study then your Scholarship may be withdrawn. If you make any changes to your original MSc of study you must notify the MSc Office Team about this, as it may affect your continued eligibility.

### **Suspensions and withdrawal from studies**

If you suspend or withdraw from your studies then you will not be eligible to receive any future payments in that year and your fee waiver will be re-calculated.

All scholarships paid/set off against fees will be calculated on a pro rata basis and any overpayments may need to be repaid to the University should you suspend, withdraw from studies, or transfer to a non-eligible MSc, or no longer be eligible for a particular scholarship for any other reason, (in such a case the University may seek to recover the amount of the overpayment as a debt in the county court).

### **Repeating, extending or deferring your studies**

The scholarships outlined herein will not be paid during any extension/repeat period(s) to your MSc. You may be able to apply for Hardship Funds from the Money Advice Team should you find yourself in financial difficulty. The scholarships outlined herein are for 2018 entry only. If you defer or withdraw and restart, any scholarship already offered will become void. If eligible, you may be considered for support the following year, but this will be subject to the terms of this scholarship then in force. There is no guarantee that postgraduate students will be eligible for funding in future years.

### **Changes to your immigration status**

If you have a change to your immigration status you MUST notify the School of Management MSc Office Team immediately. We may require you to provide documentary evidence of your change in status.

If you receive notice that you are liable to be detained by the UK Home Office then your scholarship will be suspended for the duration of your detention. The University will review the support available to you to help you resume your studies if your status enables you to continue.

### **Disciplinary action and fraudulent applications**

The University reserves the right to terminate your scholarship award and demand repayment of sums that have already been set off against your tuition fees in the case of any disciplinary action being taken against you. Cases will be considered on an individual basis by the Head of MSc Operations.

The University reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship from anyone who is found to have misled the University about any aspect of their eligibility and to seek repayment of any sums that have already been set off against their tuition fees. In such cases the University may seek to recover any money paid as a debt in the county court (in which case it may also seek to recover additional sums such as interest, court fees and legal costs). We may request at any point, for audit purposes, evidence of the criteria as stated in your application.

## **Additional Terms and Conditions**

- If a scholarship is awarded to a conditional offer holder, then any scholarship will also be conditional on the student achieving the conditions of entry.
- In the case of multiple applications from the same candidate, only the earliest application received by date will be considered.
- Please also ensure that you keep your email address up to date in your Bath Application Tracker as you may also receive email alerts about our scholarships provision. It is a requirement that the email address provided is your personal email address and not the address of an educational representative or agent.
- Please note that the University does not award scholarships in order of application and does not start selection until after the closing date.
- All awardees are expected to participate in publicity for the scholarships and perform student ambassador duties from time to time during the academic year.
- You cannot be considered for an award if you have not submitted your application along with any appropriate evidence by the published deadlines.
- Awards cannot be claimed retrospectively and unsuccessful applications will not be reconsidered.
- Feedback will not be provided on unsuccessful applications or decisions on award scholarships in any circumstances.
- Only awardees will be notified of a successful scholarship award.
- If you already have a partial scholarship from another organisation (including another University of Bath scholarship) for part of your tuition fees, you can combine these scholarships, provided that it does not equal more than the cost of your tuition fees. However, we will not give a University of Bath scholarship to anyone who already has a full scholarship (from another organisation) to pay for their tuition fees. If you're financial situation changes, then the University reserves the right to reconsider the award.
- The University reserves the right to review application closing dates to ensure the allocation of awards is met in full.
- We may request at any point, for audit purposes, evidence of any criteria as stated in your application.
- Scholarships cannot be deferred and are for the 2018-2019 academic entry year only.

## **5. Selection**

Selection will be based on your supporting statement submitted in your scholarship application and other contextual information, as provided in your application to study at Bath.

A selection panel will meet to decide upon applications and allocation of this fund. This will normally comprise of the Head of MSc Operations, Senior Academic and Admissions. They will make allocations at their discretion.

You cannot be considered for an award if you have not responded to our invitation to submit a scholarship application along with any relevant supporting evidence, within the application deadline. All awards are discretionary and limited in number, so even if you meet the criteria you are not guaranteed to receive one.

## 6. Definitions

The following definitions apply.

### **International student means**

those students who are classed as international as assessed for fees purposes.

### **Home (UK) Student means**

those students who are classed as Home (UK) (England, Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland), as assessed for fees purposes.

### **Home (EU) Student means**

those students who are classed as Home (EU) (European member countries), as assessed for fee purposes.

### **Appeals**

There is no right of appeal and the University's decision is final in relation to your eligibility for a scholarship. You may make a complaint if you believe that you have not been considered for a scholarship because of a procedural error, or you believe that there has been some other procedural problem with our allocating and awarding system. ## 7. Use of Data

The University may use the data / information you share with us as part of your application, to provide information and advice about the University to you as an applicant. Should you subsequently join the University, the University may also use the data you provide to inform our strategies for supporting you as a new entrant, to inform you about provision that you may be able to access, to monitor student success and for other legitimate reasons. All awardees are expected to participate in publicity for the scholarships and perform student ambassador duties from time to time during the academic year. In the case of scholarships which are funded by a corporate or private donor, personal details may be passed to this third party for example if you are awarded the Santander Scholarship to assist them to administer the award you're name, email and programme of study may be disclosed to them.
